WRIGHT-PATTERSON AIR FORCE BASE, Ohio – The Air Force Reserve's 445th Airlift Wing invites members of the media to attend a series of commemorative events Sept. 19–21 in honor of War veterans and the 20th anniversary of Honor Flight Dayton.

These events, part of Operation Honor, will spotlight the unveiling of a newly renamed aircraft, a historic Honor Flight mission, and a community-wide welcome home celebration.

What: The 445th AW will unveil the newly designated C-17 “Spirit of Hanoi Taxi,” honoring the original C-141 that repatriated American POWs from Vietnam.

Honor Flight Departure

What: About 165 veterans will board the newly named C-17 the “Spirit of Hanoi Taxi,” and an additional C-17 crewed by the 911th Airlift Wing, Pittsburgh Air Reserve Station, for a daylong journey to Washington, D.C. to visit national memorials.

When: Sunday, Sept. 21 | Media access: 4–6 a.m.
